DISCIPLESHIP-CYCLE EXAMPLE: Contact Evangelism Prayer Walk

Part #1: Following Jesus/Hear the Word

Explain how prayer will be part of the experience, and what you will be praying for:

Prayer will be part of the activity as you walk, in our case the Greek houses, we will pray for each house and the people we know in those houses.

Part #2: Into Mission/Active Response


Describe the missional experience (active response) to apply the scripture:

"I noticed over the last year how many students from Greek houses I walk past as I do a prayer walk. Instead of just praying for students, what if every prayer there is the challenge of having at least one intentional conversation with someone?"

"Ask the student how it felt to not only pray, but also talk to individuals about Jesus. Ask them to bring someone else next time we do a prayer walk (in my case it will be 3 times a week). Ask how we can be praying for the people we came in contact with. Did God put anything on their heart as we talked with students or prayed for houses?"
