

**DISCIPLESHIP-CYCLE EXAMPLE:** *Contact Evangelism Prayer Walk*

**Part #1: Following Jesus/Hear the Word**

*To give students the eyes to see that the harvest is plentiful, that even through a prayer time there is opportunity also for evangelism*

- *We are going into a place where we may feel like lambs among wolves, but take ownership of the authority Christ has given us*

*Prayer will be part of the activity as you walk, in our case the Greek houses, we will pray for each house and the people we know in those houses.*

**Describe the missional experience (active response) to apply the scripture:**

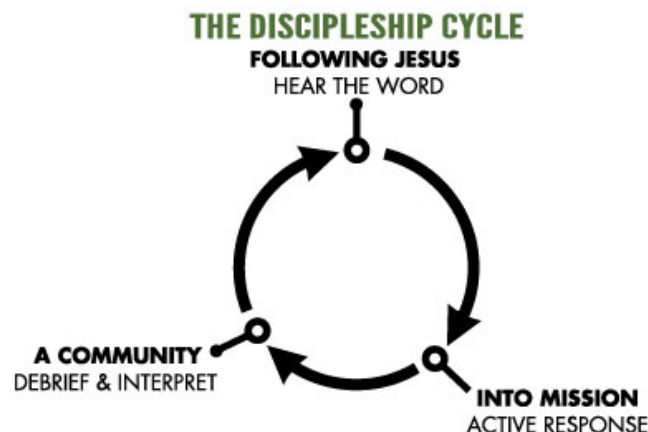
